2. The applicant has aggrieved vide transfer order dated 22.05.2026 from Wanoja Round (Katepurna Wild Life Century), Akola to Warwant Bakal Round, Sonala Range, Akot Wild Life. The challenge is on the ground that in terms of Clause B (ii) of G.R. dated 15.03.2017; on completion of one posting at Wild Life of Forester is to be transferred at Territorial Wing. Secondly, the applicant has questioned the competence of the transferring authority by relying on the communication dated 20.05.2022.
3. Issue notice to Respondents, returnable in four weeks. Learned P.O./C.P.O. waives notice for the State. Hamdast allowed.
4. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
5. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation / notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by

Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Respondent is put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

6. This Intimation / notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.

7. The service may be done by Hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.

8. S.O. to four weeks.

9. The Id. counsel for the applicant made a statement that applicant has not been relieved till date. In view of that party to maintain status quo till next date.
